

LOGISTICS MARKET - AN OVERVIEW

The logistics is the backbone of the global economy, connecting businesses, consumers, and nations through efficient movement and distribution of goods and services. Its continued development and optimization are essential for fostering economic growth, trade, and sustainable development worldwide. The global logistics market size was accounted for USD 9.7 trillion in 2024 and it is expected to be worth around USD 15.9 trillion by 2032 with a noteworthy CAGR of 6.4% from 2024 to 2032.

India being one of the fastest growing economies in the world has a great potential for growth in every sector. India's transportation and logistics industry is set to play a pivotal role in supporting the country's ambitious growth aspirations to reach a staggering US\$26 trillion by FY 2048. The India Freight and Logistics Market size is estimated at USD 317.26 billion in 2024, and is expected to reach USD 484.43 billion by 2029, growing at a CAGR of 8.83% during the forecast period (2024-2029). The logistics sector in India is predicted to account for 14.4% of the GDP.



The Government has launched substantial infrastructure development projects such as PM Gati Shakti, the National Logistics Policy, Logistics Efficiency Enhancement Programme (LEEP), development of Dedicated Freight Corridors (DFCs), Bharatmala Pariyojana, Sagarmala Programme, formulation of the National Rail Plan (NRP), National Infrastructure Pipeline and Jal Marg Vikas Project with a specific focus on strengthening the logistics sector. These initiatives are viewed by the industry as crucial steps towards positioning India as a central hub for manufacturing. Also, the Government increased the capital investment outlay to Rs 11 lakh crore during the recent Interim budget 2024, to build infrastructure and strengthen India's position in the global supply chain.

Given this background, CII is organising the 13th edition of "Logistics 2025" - India's Premier and focused show offering end to end solutions in the Logistics Industry. This will be part of the 26th edition of International Engineering and Technology Fair (IETF 2025), a premier biannual event of CII since the year 1975.

Logistics 2025 will be an ideal platform for companies involved in Logistics, Supply Chain, Transportation, Shipping & Port, Material Handling, Warehousing & Storage Equipment, Automation & Robotics, Consultancy and IT related business to showcase on their products & service, latest trends and Technologies to the industry and to strengthen their brand awareness to the stakeholders.
